Mark 9:35 (NKJV)

"And he sat down, called the twelve, and said to them, *"If anyone desires to be first, he shall be last of all and servant of all."*

2 Timothy 2:13 (NKJV)

"If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself."
